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CHAPTER 1

GENERAL LICENSE PROVISIONS

ARTICLE A. LICENSE FEES

SECTION:

3-1A-1: Schedule of Fees

3-1A-1: SCHEDULE OF FEES: Unless otherwise provided in a separate ordinance or chapter of this Code, application shall be made for a license and a fee shall be paid. In cases where stores carry more than one line of any item, article, merchandise or business or type of business, a separate license is required for each line, as if such item, article, merchandise or business or type of business were sold or carried on in that line to the exclusion of all other businesses. Building permit fees, water rates, signs, mobile home parks and other specific items are covered by other provisions of this Code.¹ Certain licenses are subject to other provisions of this Village Code and reference made to them. License fees for the businesses listed in this Section shall be displayed by the applicant at the time said license is obtained in accordance with Chapter 1 of this Title. Any person or entity that fails to obtain and display said license by February 1 will be assessed an additional ten percent (10%) fee every month thereafter until paid in full.
