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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 “LIQUOR CONTROL” OF TITLE FOUR “BUSINESS & LICENSE REGULATIONS” OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HODGKINS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

(CLASSIFICATION: HOURS)

WHEREAS, the Village of Hodgkins, Cook County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(A), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hodgkins (the “Corporate Authorities”) may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Hodgkins when it is determined to be in the best interest of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village to amend the liquor license regulations of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hodgkins, Cook County, Illinois by and through its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section **4-2-5 Alcohol** (“License Classifications”) is hereby amended by adding the new underlined language to read, as follows:

(D) Class D-1 License, Gas Station: This license shall authorize the retail sale of beer, wine and spirits only but not for consumption on the premises where sold. Licensed premises shall be primarily engaged in the sale of gasoline and petroleum products. No more than ten percent (10%) of the retail floor area open to public shall be allocated for the display and/or sale of beer and/or wine. Beer and/or wine shall not be sold after Twelve o’clock (12:00 A.M.) - Six o’clock (6:00A.M).

(D) Class D-2 License, Gas Station-with Video Gaming: This license shall authorize the retail sale of beer and wine only and beer, wine and spirits for consumption on the premises where sold. Licensed premises shall be primarily engaged in the sale of gasoline and petroleum products. For retail sales, no more than ten (10%) of the retail floor area open to public shall be allocated for display and/or sale of beer wine and/or spirits . For consumption on premises, business operating gas station shall have greater than fifty percent (50%) of the gross sales of the business are derived from the sale of petroleum products subject to the following conditions: beer, wine and spirits shall only be served in and restricted to a specific room or area within the licensed premises that is sufficiently separated from the remainder of the licensed premises by walls or other physical barriers such that the designated area cannot be viewed from the remainder of the licensed premises and the only persons over the age of twenty-one (21) may be admitted to the area. Beer and/or wine shall not be sold after twelve o'clock (12:00A.M.) for retail sales and consumption on premises.

(E) Class E-Special Event Licenses: The Local Liquor Control Commissioner may, at his or her discretion, issue a special event license for events including, but not limited to, picnics, conventions, celebrations, holiday festivals, club meetings and other assemblies. Such event shall last no more than one week. No transfer of such license shall be permitted. The Liquor Commissioner shall promulgate rules regarding the particulars of the license including, but not limited to, name of the individual or organization where the event is to be held and the day or days the event is to take place. (2016 Code).

Section 3. The Corporate Authorities of the Village intend that this Ordinance will be made part of the Village Code and that sections revised herein be renumbered or re-lettered and internal references updated to reflect and renumbering or re-lettering in order to accomplish codification.


Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


