Mr. O'Connell stated that we have two cases pending at this time. One case is the Eminent Domain of Commendation against the Dostal property.

The other case is for the disconnection of 53.5 acres from property owned by UPS from the Village of Willow Springs, which is pending. This case will be filed in approximately a week or so. Both cases are pending.

Report from Chief of Police, Ernest Millsap

Chief Millsap reported that on 6/25/15, He and Lt. Ceplecha attended the Cook County Emergency Operation Center open house in Oak Forest. The center has resources to handle 134 Cook County Municipalities and serves as the central agency in Cook County for coordinating efforts to prevent, protect against, respond and recover from all incidents whether man made or natural.

Chief Millsap reported that the Police Department has started its first bike patrol program. 6 officers have been trained to handle the bicycles in different police situations. This is a current expansion of the foot patrol that we have had for several years.

The police department received a thank you letter from resident Madeline Peterson, 66 Park Lane. She had a large tree fall behind her mobile home and called for help. The officers were able to help her get out of her home safely. Building Department Director, Tim Kovel and the Forest Preserve District handled the situation with minimal damage to Ms. Peterson's mobile home. A special thanks to Mr. Kovel on his help in this matter.

Phase three and four of the camera project is in progress, which is Weeping Willow road. This will hopefully be completed by the end of summer.

Report from Superintendent of Public Works, Jack Scott

Mr. Scott reported that the water main progress is moving very slowly in Park view mobile home. This is partly due to weather and the experience of the crew working on the project. The main will be filled with water tomorrow and flushed out. The chlorinator will come in and check the samples, two with in 24 hour periods. The project is almost complete.
