Mr. Cummings states that this has an advantage for both parties when water supplies are interrupted on either side. We will need to use the crossover soon for the project on Lenzi Avenue. Mr. Struve states that the water pressure will increase about ten pounds, however, we will be monitoring the pressure. Mrs. Moxley asked if the residents would notice any changes, Mr. Struve states that he does not think they will notice. Motion to approve by Mr. Christopher. Second by Mr. Rice. Additionally, Mr. O'Connell states that the integrity of the current department and the administrative excellence he has brought to the department is extremely impressive. the improvement he has brought to the department will probably not be recognized for a few years down the road. The department has grown and the quality of the department has never been better. Clearly, Chief Kringlie has left an impressive and indelible mark.

Chief Kringlie is appreciative of the kind comments and adds that he has learned from his predecessors and is humble by the comments.

- Officer Pierce has been off with on the job injuries for almost a year and is expected to return to duty soon. The shoulder and elbow surgeries hopefully have cured his condition. He is to report to the surgeon this Thursday and hoping to be released.
