AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND MAKING PUBLIC THE MINUTES OF CERTAIN CLOSED SESSION MINUTES

WHEREAS, Illinois law provides that municipalities may conduct closed sessions provided issues being discussed fall under certain categories cited under the Illinois Open Meeting Act; and

WHEREAS, Illinois law also provides that after the confidentiality of said issues no longer exists that the municipality review the matter in closed session and then vote on making closed session minutes open to the public at a meeting of the Board of Trustees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees for the Village of Hodgkins the following:

Section 1

The closed session minutes of the following dates shall be made public at the April 24, 2023 open meeting the Board of Trustees: April 12,2021, July 27, 2021, September 20, 2021, December 13, 2021, March 14, 2022, May 9, 2022, June 13, 2022, September 12, 2022, November 14, 2022, December 12, 2022, February 13, 2023 and March 13, 2023.

The closed session minutes of April 10, 2023 shall remain closed at the April 24, 2023 open meeting of the Board of Trustees.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 2

If any action, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3

All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions that are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict herewith.

Section 4

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval. The Village Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form after its adoption.
