ORDINANCE NO. 19-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HODGKINS BY THE DELETION OF TITLE 3, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE F. REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX AND INSERTING IN LIEU THEREOF TITLE 3, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE F. MUNICIPAL CANNABIS RETAILERS' OCCUPATION TAX

WHEREAS, the Village, as a Home Rule municipality, has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs that protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Cannabis Retailers' Occupation Tax Law, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-22; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is intended to impose the tax authorized by the Municipal Cannabis Retailers' Occupation Tax Law providing for a municipal cannabis retailers' occupation tax which will be collected by the Illinois Department of Revenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hodgkins as follows:

Section 1

Recitals. The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2

Deletion of REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX. ARTICLE F. REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:

Adoption of Tax. TITLE 3, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE F. MUNICPAL CANNABIS RETAILERS' OCCUPATION TAX

3-3F-1 - Tax imposed; Rate

- A. A tax is hereby imposed upon all persons engaged in the business of selling cannabis, other than cannabis purchased under the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act, at retail in the Village of Hodgkins at the rate of three percent of the gross receipts from these sales made in the course of that business.
- B. The imposition of this tax is in accordance with the provisions of Section 8-11-22 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILSC 5/8-11-22).

3-3F-2 - Collection of tax by retailers.

A. The tax imposed by Section 3-3F-1 shall be remitted by such retailer to the Illinois Department of Revenue. Any tax required to be collected pursuant to or as authorized by this Ordinance and any such tax collected by such retailer

and required to be remitted to the Illinois Department of Revenue shall constitute a debt owed by the retailer to the State of Illinois. A retailer may reimburse itself for its seller's tax liability hereunder by separately stating that tax as an addition charge, which charge may be stated in combination, in a single amount, with an State of Illinois tax that a seller is required to collect.

B. The taxes hereby imposed, and all civil penalties that may be assessed as an incident thereto, shall be collected and enforced by the Illinois Department of Revenue. The Illinois Department of Revenue shall have full power to administer and enforce the provisions of this Chapter 3-3F.

Section 3

Retroactive Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law, provided, however that the tax provided for herein shall take effect for all sales on or after the first day of January 2020. Copies of this Ordinance shall be certified and immediately sent to the Illinois Department of Revenue.

Section 4

If any action, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are here by repealed insofar as the conflict herewith.
