Waste Management came back the most beneficial and has additional services and a lower cost. The day of collection would be modified from Wednesday to Friday should the Board choose to change providers. Waste Management was willing to negotiate prices and provide a 5-year contract vs. 3-year contract. Hazardous waste and electronics can be picked up at a person's front door also. The Board will be provided with further information prior to the next Informational Meeting.
