Mr. Misasi discussed the request from Illinois Department of Transportation to perform construction activities during the hours of 9:00pm and 5:00am on LaGrange Road. This work includes resurfacing improvements, such as asphalt removal, pavement patching, structural adjustments, and all other work associated with the resurfacing project. The Illinois Department of Transportation is looking for an answer by January 31, 2018. The Village Board has given the Public Works Committee the authority to approve or deny this work.

Mr. Misasi said he has been monitoring the traffic and to avoid the traffic grid lock that would be caused by work during the day time hours he suggests the work be done at night as requested. Mr. Misasi also suggested that we possibly have our Village Attorney talk with the Illinois Department of Transportation about putting up a temporary sound fence just in front of Weeping Willow since this work would be bothersome to the residents. This project is not scheduled to start until March, 2019.
